

SAFETY CLEANING CHECKLIST AND PROCESS

ON ENTRY:

- On entering the buildings use the hand sanitiser.
- Gather the spray bottle provided and wipe down all hard surfaces in the Kitchen, Bathroom and Toilet areas. This includes all door handles and tap handles.
- Wash hands well after this process.

Note: It is important to recognise that the previous visitor may have missed some cleaning steps, so it is a good practice to clean your way into the buildings.

KITCHEN

- All kitchen equipment or utensils MUST be washed in hot soapy water then dried BEFORE usage.
- All kitchen equipment and utensils MUST be washed and dried after use before leaving.
- DO NOT leave utensils or crockery to dry on the rack.
- Bring your own Tea Towels. Club Tea towels, if used, are to be taken home with you and washed prior to returning them to the clubrooms or shack.
- DO NOT leave tea towels hanging to dry on the back of chairs.
- Use the spray bottle of disinfectant and disposable paper towelling supplied to wipe down all hard surfaces in the kitchen/dining/living area.
- Make sure to remove all rubbish from the bin and fit a new bin liner before departure.

BATHROOM

- Using the spray bottle of disinfectant and disposable paper towelling to wipe down the sink, taps and shower areas.
- At the end of your visit repeat this process.

SHOWER

- After showering, use the squeegee provided to clean down the shower walls.
- Use YOUR towel to mop up any remaining water.
- Use the spray bottle to disinfect the shower cubicle before completing your visit.
- Take YOUR wet towels home with you.

TOILET

- Wipe down the flush buttons and toilet seat PRIOR to use.
- At the end of your visit repeat this process.

BEDROOMS

- You must provide YOUR own bedding and pillows.
- All pillows left at the shacks will be removed for safety reasons.
- Please double check that you have removed all your clothing and equipment before departure.
- Wipe down all hard surfaces and door handles at the end of your visit.

RECORD YOUR VISIT

- Record in the SHACK LOGBOOK all visitors NAMES and DATES of who were in residence.

Note: This is a vital step. Not only is it a club bylaw governing the use of these shacks, but it is a legal requirement to be able to trace users in the event of a covid-19 outbreak.

SANITISER

- The sanitiser/disinfectant supplied is a “general purpose” product designed for use on hard surfaces in domestic situations and is non-toxic when used in its recommended dilution.

Note: Please notify either the Secretary or President if the cleaning supply is running low to ensure further supplies are provided.
