The club aims to promote and foster fly fishing as a fun and exciting sport for people of all ages and gender.

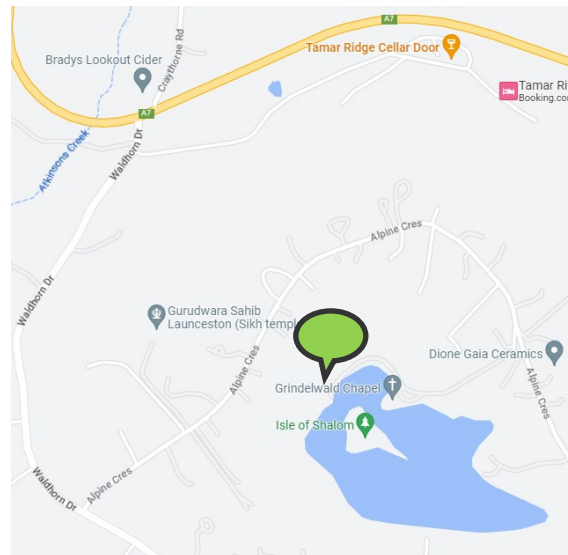
The club holds multiple outings each year as well as reciprocal fishing adventures with other fly fishing clubs throughout the state.
